

ELA COURSE FLOWCHART

All students must successfully complete 4 ELA credits in order to meet graduation requirements. In addition, those students are required to score proficient or advanced on the Literature Keystone Exam as a state graduation requirement. Those that don't score proficient or advanced must meet statewide graduation requirements through one of four other pathways as part of Act 158. The Literature Keystone exam is given at the end of the 10th grade English course as indicated in the chart with an asterisk (*).
