
In cooperation with the Pennsylvania Department of Health, the school district would like to pass along the new COVID-19 restrictions posted yesterday:

“Pennsylvanians who visit other states are **required** to have a negative COVID-19 test within 72 hours prior to their return to the Commonwealth, or they are **required** to quarantine for 14 days upon their return to Pennsylvania. This order takes effect on Friday, November 20th.”

Due to the large increase in the number of active cases in our community and surrounding areas, we must remain diligent in following the policies already in place, and in implementing the new guidance coming from the Department of Health.
